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Order No. 14: INITIAL DETERMINATION Modifying Target Date

The target date for completion of this enforcement proceeding is currently May 28, 2010, and thus the Enforcement Initial Determination (“EID”) is due on January 28, 2010.² In order to accommodate the undersigned’s schedule, the evidentiary hearing has been moved to January 11, 2010. *See* Order No. 13. Consequently, the target date and EID due date must be adjusted to accommodate the new hearing schedule.


Accordingly, it is the INITIAL DETERMINATION of the undersigned that July 19, 2010 is the target date for completion of this proceeding. Thus, the EID is due on March 19, 2010.

Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(h), this initial determination shall become the determination of the Commission unless a party files a petition for review of the initial determination pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.43(a), or the Commission, pursuant to 19 C.F.R.



Exchange and serve lists of (up to 10) high priority objections	December 4, 2009
Staff files prehearing statement	December 9, 2009


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
