**ORDER NO. 15: DENYING MOTION FOR SUMMARY DETERMINATION THAT
SAMSUNG SATISFIES THE ECONOMIC PRONG OF THE DOMESTIC INDUSTRY
REQUIREMENT**

(September 8, 2009)

On July 31, 2009, Complainants Samsung Electronics Company, Ltd. and Samsung Electronics America, Inc. (collectively, "Samsung") filed a motion (671-006) for summary determination that Samsung satisfies the economic prong of the domestic industry requirement.¹

On August 17, 2009, Respondent Eastman Kodak Company ("Kodak") filed an opposition to the motion, and the Commission Investigative Staff ("Staff") filed a response in support of said motion.

On August 21, 2009, Kodak filed an unopposed motion (671-011) for leave to file a reply to Staff's response, which is hereby granted. On August 26, 2009, Samsung filed an unopposed motion (671-014) for leave to file a reply in support of its motion for summary determination, which is hereby granted.


Having reviewed and considered Samsung's motion and the responses thereto and finding that genuine issues of material fact may remain, it is determined that good cause does not exist to

grant the motion in lieu of a trial of all issues on the merits. Accordingly, the motion (671-006) is hereby denied.


