Order No. 31 (Initial Determination)

On this date, the undersigned received the “Joint Motion to Terminate Enforcement Proceeding As to Respondents Vizio, Inc.; AmTran Technology Co., Ltd.; and Suzhou Raken Technology, Ltd.” (Motion No. 617-140). Subsequently, the undersigned received a copy of the opinion of the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit concerning the underlying investigation, which also issued on this date.

Consequently, in order to provide the parties the opportunity to comment on both the settlement and Federal Circuit decision, it is the INITIAL DETERMINATION of the undersigned that the target date shall be extended by one month, *i.e.*, to October, 27, 2010, and thus the Enforcement Initial Determination (“EID”) shall be due by June 28, 2010. *See* Order No. 4 (setting original target date); Comm’n Order at 4 (Sept. 4, 2009) (The “target date is to exceed the date of issuance of the ALJ’s EID by four months.”).

An order setting a schedule for the parties to comment on the Federal Circuit decision shall issue shortly.

Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(h), this initial determination shall become the determination of the Commission unless a party files a petition for review of the initial

determination pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.43(a), or the Commission, pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.44, orders on its own motion a review of the initial determination or certain issues contained herein.


